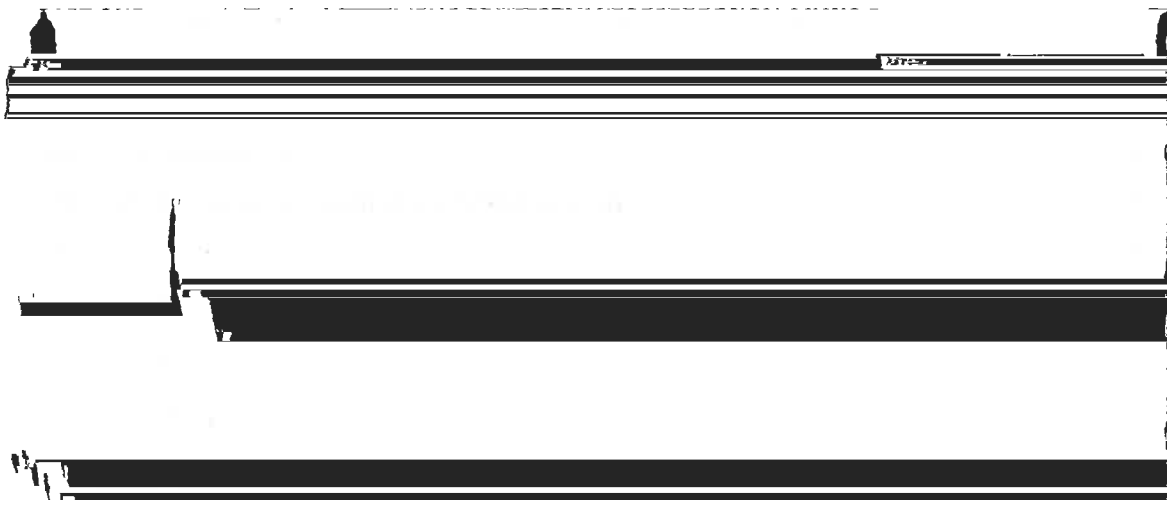


**BBC/IS AGREE E T**

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This Agreement is between:

- (1) THE BRITISH BROADCASTING CORPORATION, of Broadcasting House, Portland Place, London W1A 1AA ("the BBC"), and
- (2) THE INCORPORATED SOCIETY OF MUSICIANS of 4-5 Inverness Mews, London, W2 3JQ ("the ISM")

(A) SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement sets out the minimum terms and conditions for:

(i) the engagement of professional musicians (who perform music for part or whole of their livelihood) to give Performance(s) for inclusion in BBC Content as a:

- Soloist (instrumentalist and vocalist) or as a Conductor in a concert

**(B) PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF AGREEMENT**

**This Agreement shall:**

- (i) ~~be in full force and effect from 1st April 2010 ("the Commencement Date")~~
- (ii) replace all Previous Agreements with the ISM concerning the subject matter of this Agreement; and
- (iii) continue to have effect unless or until terminated by either party giving six months' written notice to the other. ~~Neither party may give such notice before 1st April 2022~~

Any proposed revisions to this Agreement by either party shall be subject to written notice, and any agreed revision shall remain in force for at least 12 months before any further revision to the same provision can be proposed.

1.1 Musicians shall be paid an engagement fee comprising **Public Concert Fee** and a **Relay Fee**.

**Public Concert** A programme of Live Performance(s) given for an audience.
